

Opportunities for Students

Buy 1lb boxes of chocolate: we will be giving a fleece jacket to each elder with our logo with a box of chocolates.

Buy a medium tin of butter cookies: we will be giving a tin of butter cookies to each elder.

Homemade Holiday cards: students can do a homemade card that we will add in the holiday bag for each elder.

Decorate white bags for the elder's birthdays: see attached pictures. Students can decorate the front side of the white bags with "Happy Birthday" and add a decoration. Size of the bags (I will need to get back to you with that).

Assemble hard candy favors: students would assemble a handful of hard candy in small cellophane bags and attach a note with a message saying "enjoy the day" or "thinking of you" on one side and on the other side the name of the school. I have attached pictures for you.

Do a food drive: we have a pantry and we deliver every month more than 100 food bags. I have attached the link for the food drive. Or you can collect the food at your school. We could pick up.

Volunteer option: If students are interested in volunteering directly they could participate with their parents in an orientation and the parent would do the background check. Then they could help us deliver meals on Thanksgiving and Christmas as well as deliver holiday gifts. I have attached the flier that you could send to parents.
